3/7/19 Meeting Minutes

The School Health Advisory Council met in the library.

Those present: parents: Cynthia Newton, Fabiola Patino, and Benita Zarate,
School Representatives: Patti Blue- Superintendent, Kenny Eudy- administrator
and Lisa Connel- Nurse.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as written.

Mrs. Connel gave reports on:

- Sweetheart Breakfast which was held on February 14. 47 adults participated in the breakfast.
- 49 students traveled to Fort Worth on Saturday February 23rd to participate in the Cowton Kids 5K. 11 faculty/staff and 3 parents also participated in the race. Approximately 12 others adults accompanied the students. The students were able to participate in this event due to the receipt of grant monies and also through the generous donations of community members. It was noted that out of 127 teams who competed in the race, Gustine placed 8th. An article highlighting the students who participated along with the times of the notable finishers was placed in the Comanche Chief.
- Gustine scored at a "Gold Level" on the Smarter Lunchroom Scorecard. It was also noted that the cafeteria has begun to offer a new salad option that has been very popular.
- The results from a survey which was conducted for the high school students in regard to the need for a Second Chance Breakfast were given. Mr. Eudy reported that the 2019/2020 school year schedule is currently being evaluated to possibly allow for a later breakfast time for the high school students.
- 3rd grade is scheduled to participate in Safety City in Abilene, TX on March 8th.

Members discussed the Health Fair which will be held on April 15. Discussion included organizations who have agreed to participate, publicity, snacks and games to go along with the "Hamster Game" theme. It was agreed that further planning information could be shared via email.

The next meeting was scheduled for April 30, 2019.
